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ON THE FUNCTIONING PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN'S HEALTH AND RECREATION IN UKRAINE AND ISRAEL

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Prominent places in the organization of meaningful leisure, recreation and health improvement for children and students are occupied by summer children's health camps (hereinafter SCHC). Educational work at SCHC includes a combination of recreation, sports with cognitive, aesthetic, wellness activities. The content, forms and methods of work in SCHC are determined by its charter, pedagogical team and are based on the principles of initiative and activity of children and student youth, democracy and humanism, development of national and cultural and historical traditions, priority of universal spiritual achievements and values.

In accordance with the Law of Ukraine «On Recreation and Health Improvement of Children», we define the basic conceptual and terminological tools of research:

Rest shift – period of stay of the child in the children's institution of health and rest at least 14 days;

Wellness change – period of stay of the child in the children's institution of health and rest not less than 21 days, during which the child receives health and rest services;

The wellness program is a package of documents that determine the amount of funding.

Education of students is a complex and multifaceted process of personality formation, creation of optimal conditions for physical, mental, and social development. Educational work in summer children's camps has several specific features:

1. The educational process in the summer wellness camp is planned and carried out considering that the children are completely separated from the family, parental care and protection, their educational impact. Therefore, the pedagogical staff of the camp should ensure the full life of children.

2. All types of educational activities are carried out in temporary multi-age groups, with different social experiences of children, living conditions and upbringing.

3. Educational work is based on the principles of voluntary participation of children in various affairs, in the free choice of their classes.

4. The short period of existence of the camp staff requires a clear start and completion of the camp change, a mandatory assessment of each child's activity.

5. In a new environment, during active communication, the child's personality is more fully revealed.

6. In the educational process of the summer wellness camp, both professional educators and representatives of the intelligentsia, workers, students who build their relationships with children are involved, often based on pedagogical intuition and their own experience.

7. Educational process in SCHC is carried out in favorable conditions of natural and social environment.

8. Educational work with children should ensure compliance with the regime of the day, the order and cleanliness of sleeping homes, the cleanliness of linen, the fulfillment of sanitary and hygienic requirements by children. Particular attention should be paid to organizing educational work to preserve the health of children, prevent disease, create order and comfort in sleeping quarters, play rooms, cinemas, rest areas. Food culture plays a significant role in educational work with children.

9. The peculiarity of educational work in the children's health camp is the improvement of children using the year, lakes, sea, forest, transport excursions. It is here that the educational work on self-preservation of life of children and caregivers, prevention of possible traumatism and diseases should be clear.

10. There are educational tasks that need to be addressed during the change. The wines create a tense rhythm of work of the whole teaching staff, mobilize its creative forces and help in achieving the main goal of improving the children: creating an emotional mood in them, introducing the mood of the game, romance in their daily life; identification of interests, hobbies of children, development of desire to acquire new knowledge, skills, skills; joint activity of children in the team; involvement in labor matters for the benefit and joy of others.

The small residents of Poltava are recovering in accordance with the law of Ukraine «On improving and resting children» and the Program of financing summer establishments of rest of Poltava region for 2015-2019.

For the conduct of the 2015-2019 health seasons the Executive Committee of the Poltava City Council has created a bill which is planned to amend the city budget in order to increase the amount of money allocated for organizing a proper, meaningful holiday for teenagers in the summer of 2016; UAH 26.3 million to UAH 110.4 million Thanks to this project, the privileges will be able to rest for free, and the parents of the rest will be able to purchase the ticket by paying only 30% of its cost (about UAH 1.6 thousand). This decision is dated May 11, 2018.

According to the decision, the children will be able to rest in 46 preschool wellness establishments and two summer camps: «Olympic hopes» (village Sosnivka of Poltava district) and «Satellite» (village Mykhailivka of Dykansky district). In the school camps one change will be 14 days, «Satellite» and «Olympic hopes» – 21 days.

At the expense of the regional budget, the Department of Education and Science of the RSA has rehabilitated 800 talented children, 63 orphans and deprived parental care students in boarding schools, as well as 400 children living in Donetsk and Luhansk region. In addition, 900 out-of-town camps will be rehabilitated, requiring special social attention and support.

Poltava students have traditionally been able to rest in the camps: «Artek» and «Young Guard». Since the beginning of 2019, 236 children have been rehabilitated there. Local budgets have purchased vouchers for nearly 3,800 privileged children.

Through this program, organized recreation and recreation have reached about 75,000 children. About 148 million UAH were raised for organizing and conducting the summer wellness campaign, of which more than 110 million - from the regional and local budgets.

The Poltava City District Administration of the State Sanitary Service has made several measures for timely preparation of country camps for work in the summer wellness season of 2019. Targeted plans are addressed to the heads of children's camps, with the aim of preventing diseases of acute intestinal infections, to create optimal, safe conditions for children's health.

Different age groups have extensive educational opportunities: it is a direct transfer of experience from senior to younger, it is the realization of age needs (the younger ones - to have a friend and be like him, in the older ones – to establish himself as a leader).

In August, a children's summer camp is held in Rehovot, Israel, to introduce children to the history, traditions and culture of Ukraine. The program includes an excursion into history, language training, Ukrainian dances and songs, traditional cooking, master classes from the Petrykivsky List, as well as interesting quests, a swimming pool and field trips.

Outreach programs take place in camps outside the city and include accommodation, food and educational and entertaining content.

Daytime programs run in the city from morning till evening. During 7-10 days the participants will get acquainted with the Jewish world and the Israeli culture. At the same time, they get acquainted not only in theory but also in practice. Each day of the program is filled with a variety of professional workshops, creative and developing classes.

Completion of the program always depends on the age of the participants, the interests of children and young people. This makes each program exciting and informative, filled with emotions and impressions, new skills and knowledge! Professional and experienced presenters (madrihi) from CIS and Israel cities are preparing the program.

The effectiveness of inclusion in Israel is determined not so much by academic achievement in learning, but by changes in behavior, relationships with teachers and students, life competencies. That is, they measure the growth from the original bar, not the norms or successes of classmates. If a child who is not talking is able to translate the read text, she should be proud of herself. In our country, unfortunately, educators think this way: if a student teaches in the upper grades at the elementary school level, it is a failure, a shame, regardless of the effort and the path.

Also, Israeli future educators spoke in detail about the work of the escort team, centers for inclusive education support, interagency interaction of services, search for resources. Educators have been taught to communicate effectively with the families of children with special educational needs: for example, keep a log of contacts, schedule trainings and regular meetings.

The Israeli Ukrainians were promised post-training support and offered to apply for a competition, the winners of which will be trained in Israel. And those who are interested in the training will have another chance next year: MES has agreed with MASHAV to continue cooperation.

Summer family camps have been held annually since 1997, with the financial support of the Metro Vest Federation of Jewish Communities (New Jersey, USA). They promote Jewish upbringing of children and their parents, supplement and unite Jewish communities, intensify the work of community and children's programs at Hesed, and help unlock the capabilities of each participant.

The following provisions are important for the organization of children's health camps:

- children's health camps are part of the social environment in which children realize their potential, needs for individual, physical and social competence;

- the activity of the children's health camp is based on the principle of mass and public availability of activities of interest; development of creativity and amateur activity, socially significant direction of activity; unity of health and educational work with children; relationships with family and social environment;

- Children's health camps characterize the subject-practical activities, specific life situations that help to get to know the child, to build relationships between children, children and adults.
